C. FAULKNER and RUBY H. FAULKNER, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 14.10 acres, more or less, as shown by Plat of the property of J. K. Keller made by J. Coke Smith, February 11, 1946, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of a 30-foot road leading off from the Greenville-Piedmont Highway, at joint corner of property of J. K. Keller and W. L. Vaughn, and running thence with the line of the Vaughn property N. 18-00 W. 730 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of the Vaughn property, N. 4-50 W. 601 feet to a stake, corner of property of W. D.
