CHARTER 17  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

did on the 24th. day of June, 19 52, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is MCCRARY AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER CO.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to engage in general contracting which primarily involves the sale, installation, maintenance, repair and servicing of automatic sprinkler systems; to engage in the sale, installation, repair and maintenance of all pipes and kind of pipe work; to engage in all types of industrial work related to the aforesaid and other kindred lines such as heating and water lines for industrial purposes.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) - - - - -Dollars payable with \$25,000.00 subscribed and payable in cash or its equivalent and the remaining \$25,000.00 authorized but not issued or subscribed.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Five Hundred (500) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - -Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 23rd. day of June, 19 52, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

W. H. McCrary and Thelma A. McCrary

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, W. H. McCrary ; as Vice-President, Thelma A. McCrary ; as Secretary, W. H. McCrary ; as Treasurer, W. H. McCrary

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville-Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
