This agreement entered into this 7th day of May, 1952 by and between Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, a political subdivision of Greenville County, South Carolina, and Catalina Restaurants, Inc., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H :

1. That the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. is desirous of obtaining facilities to dispose of its sanitary sewage and its present facilities are inadequate and that at the present time the property of the Catalina Restaurants, Inc., the property in question being located at the intersection of the Super Highway and the Laurens Road By-Pass, is without the limits of the City of Greenville and without the limits of the Greater Greenville Sewer District.

2. That in consideration of the promises and agreements contained herein on the part of the Catalina Restaurants, Inc., the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission does hereby agree to handle, transport and dispose of the sanitary sewage of the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. upon its delivery to the Richland Creek trunk line of the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission. The transporting of the sewage from the property of the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. to the Richland Creek trunk line shall be by agreement with Bob Jones University and/or the City of Greenville, (the present owners of the lines connecting to the trunk line).

3. In consideration of the agreement of the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission contained in the preceding paragraph, Catalina Restaurants, Inc. agrees to pay quarterly to the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission one-half the amount of its quarterly water bill as evidenced by the invoice from the Greenville City Water Works.
