Gentlemen:

Referring to lease dated June 15, 1950, last, between the lessor, to your Company as lessee, and covering the service station described, situate at the Southeast corner of Main Street and 1st Street, the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, property having subsequently been acquired by the Plaintiff, the lessor, subject to the terms and conditions of said lease, to lease the same for a further period of two (2) years and nine (9) months, commencing April 1st, 1951 and ending on the 31st day of October, 1953, the rent during such renewal period shall be the sum, payable on the 1st day of each month, equivalent to One and One-Half Cents (1 1/2) per gallon of all the lessee's brands of gasoline and/or motor fuel sold during the preceding calendar month from said premises by lessee, its agents or assigns, to the consuming trade.

It is further understood and agreed that at the expiration of the said lease, the lessee shall have the option of renewing for an additional term of (2) years on the same terms unless the lessor desires to use the property for his own use. The lessor shall give the lessee not less than thirty (30) days written notice in the event he desires to take the property at the expiration of the lease on December 31, 1953.

Except as hereinabove modified, all terms, covenants, provisions and conditions of said lease shall remain in full force and effect.

This agreement cancels and supersedes a agreement signed December 23rd, 1950.
