The Commissioners of Public Works of the Town of Landrum, South
Carolina

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Commissioners of Public Works
all my right, title and interest in the following described land
All that certain tract of land on Dockery Ridge and on the waters
of Vaughan's Creek, containing thirty acres, more or less, being a portion
of a tract containing one hundred acres, more or less, conveyed to me
by J. C. Fisher, by deed dated August 11th, 1916, Recorded in deed book
41 page 17, in office of the recorder of Deeds and conveyances of
Greenville County, South Carolina, and being that portion of said tract
conveyed to the Commissioners of Public Works of the town of Landrum
South Carolina by R. C. Remick by deed dated ~~July 30, 1921~~ and recorded
in book 77, page 231, in the office of the recorder of Deeds and
conveyances of Greenville County, South Carolina.
