(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and

by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul K. Tonckston, his heirs and assigns forever the following described property, to wit:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing seven (7) acres, more or less, and consisting of two tracts of land and being more specifically described as follows:

(1) a narrow strip of land containing approximately two (2) aprensituate on the north side of a dirt road known as "Charley Black" road and being described as follows: commercing at iron pin at intersection of Paul K. Thackston land with land of Wolf. Ferry; thence in a southerly direction along the land of W. E. Perry/where this eastern boundary line intersects with the aforesaid "Charley Black" Road; thence along said "Charley Black" road in a southwestwardly direction to a point where said road joins a creek, sometimes called "Huff" or "Rocky Ford" creek, thence in a northwestwardly direction along said creek to where same joins property of P. K. Thackston; thence in a northeasternly direction along the property of P. K. Thackston to the localing point; and

(2) an adjoining tract of land to the land described above and containing approximately five (5) acres, said land being oval or rectangular in shape and all of hich tract of land is located on the west side of the aforesaid creek, sometimes called "Huff" or "Rocky Ford" creek and being bounded on the northeast by lands of Fo K. Thackston and the aforesaid described two acre tract with the said creek intervening; on the southeast, southwest and west by Charley Black's lands; and on the northwest by lands of Mrs. Carrie Bozeman.
