Leonard in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum One Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty-five and 29/100 DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage indebtedness hereinafter set forth to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Pete Bybee, his heirs and assigns forever

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 57 according to a plat of the property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwestern side of Augusta Road, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at Page 113, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Crestfield Road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 56 N. 38-23 W. 218.1 feet; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 32 and 31 S. 48-49 W. 85.1 feet; thence along the line of Lot No. 58 S. 38-23 E. 213.7 feet; thence along the northwestern side of Crestfield Road N. 51-37 E. 85 feet to the point of beginning.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay the balance upon the following notes and mortgages:

- (1) Note and mortgage by grantor unto the Peoples National Bank dated August 19, 1948 in the original amount of \$7,000.00, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 398, Page 109, on which there is a present balance of \$6,307.88;
- (2) Note and mortgage executed by grantor unto the Peoples National Bank in the original amount of \$1,050.00, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 398, Page 113, dated August 19, 1948, on which there is a present balance of \$856.83.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

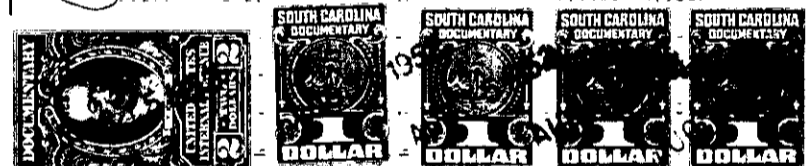
