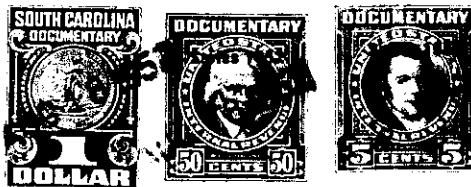

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Mary Alice Leake, by her Guardian ad Litem, Helen K. Leake

on or about the 15th day of July in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-two exhibited her
complaint in the ^{County} Court of ~~Common Pleas~~, for the County aforesaid, against
Frank S. Leake

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 17th day of July 1952,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Frank S. Leake
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Frank S. Leake, all the right, title and interest of the
minor Plaintiff herein, the same being an undivided 1/96 interest, in and
to the following described real estate:

"All that property contained in deed from Joan W. Jenkins to J. C.
Leake dated December 31, 1901, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Green-
ville County in Deed Book, Vol. III, at Page 422, said property being des-
cribed more particularly in said deed, as follows:

All those pieces, parcels or tracts of land situate, lying and being
in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, in Fairview Town-
ship about fifteen miles below the City of Greenville, S. C., near the
Laurens Road, on waters of Raven Creek;

Being lots Nos. 3 and 5 of the land surveyed and platted by J. W.
Southern, D. S. for M. F. Ansel on the 26th day of August, 1890, same being
part of the Old David Moreton tract of land purchased by M. F. Ansel at the
sale of the real estate of J. Asher Stone, dec'd. Tract No. 3 containing
forty-five and one-third (45-1/3) acres, more or less, and Tract No. 5
containing forty-seven and three-fourths (47-3/4) acres, more or less, and
fully described in the plats of the same attached to deed made to J. W.
Jenkins by M. F. Ansel on the 8th day of May, 1891, reference to said plat
