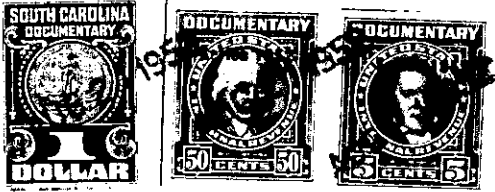

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Roy Bishop, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located about three miles north of Travelers Rest, S. C., on the western side of U. S. Highway No. 276, (Travelers Rest-Ceaser's Head Road), the same being shown and designated as lots no. 50 and 51 on a plat of the property of the "Lannie K. Hunt Estate", plat made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated Nov. 15 and 16, 1951 and recorded in plat Book AA, Page 134, R. I. C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, which is hereby incorporated herein by reference, the following courses and distances, to wit;

BEGINNING at a point on the western edge of a newly cut 36 foot street, joint corner of lots 49 and 50, and running thence S 63-30 W 200 feet to a point; thence S 26-15 E 200 feet to a point; thence N 63-30 E 200 feet to a point on the western edge of said newly cut street; thence along the western edge of said newly cut street N 26-15 W 200 feet to the beginning corner.
