The right and privilege to the full use and enjoyment of Carolina Lake (sometimes called Clearwater Lake) for the purpose of swimming, boating, fishing, and the enjoyment of any and all other aquatic sports and privileges together with the right of ingress and egress to said lake across the unplatted lands owned by the Grantor herein as shown on said plat. It is distinctly understood that rights, uses and privileges herein granted are to enure to the benefit of the Grantee, his heirs and assigns, and shall be subject to transfer and sale by the Grantee, his heirs and assigns, to any and all subsequent purchases of said lot.

This conveyance is made subject to the Restrictions and Conditions applicable to Carolina Lake Colony Development as recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book Volume 437 at Page 265.
