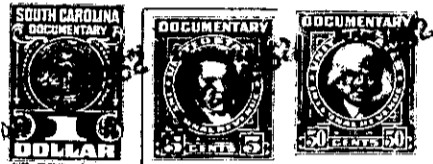
That I, A. H. Jenkins, of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Kelloy, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near City of Greenville, at corner of Summitt Avenue and Worth Street, being the northern portion of Lot Number Nineteen (No. 19) of "Riverside Farms", by plat recorded in Plat Book "51", page 177 in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and being shown and designated as Lot Number Three (No. 3) on a plat and survey of the Williams property, made by W. J. Riddle, Sur., July 28, 1950, and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at iron pin at the intersection of Summitt Avenue and Worth Street, and running thence along the western side of Worth Street, S. 10-42 W. 154 feet to point, joint corner with Lot No. 2 of said Williams property; thence N. 71-18 W. 122.2 feet along line of last mentioned property, to iron pin; thence N. 34-00 E. 171 feet to iron pin on southern side of Summitt Avenue; thence along the southern side of Summitt Avenue, S. 58-58 E. 57.2 feet to the point of beginning.
