All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the west side of Augusta Road, about 3 1/2 miles from the Old Greenville County Courthouse and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Augusta Road, corner of property previously conveyed to the Grantee by the Grantor herein and running thence along the west side of Augusta Road, N. 1-02 W. 75 feet; thence in a southwesterly direction 425 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the rear line of property of the Grantor, which iron pin is at a point 60 feet N. 28-08 W. from the northwestern rear corner of property heretofore conveyed to Dancy; thence S. 28-08 E. 60 feet to the rear corner of property heretofore conveyed to Dancy; thence along the property perviously conveyed, N. 70-23 E. 416.2 feet to the point of beginning on the western side of Augusta Road, being a portion of the property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of S. D. Stewart by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 298, Page 306.
