All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being more particularly described as a portion of Lot 22 according to a plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book I, at pages 69 and 70, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the Southern line of Lot 21 as shown on said plat, and running thence S. 18-43 W. 150 feet to a point in the northern line of Lot 23 as shown on said plat; thence along the northern line of Lot 23, S. 71-17 E. 85 feet to a point in the northern line of Lot 23 as shown on said plat; thence N. 18-43 E. 150 feet to a point in the southern line of Lot 21 as shown on said plat; thence along the southern line of Lot 21, N. 71-17 W. 85 feet to the beginning corner.

The northern line of Lot 23 as shown on the plat herein referred to is now the northern boundary of Rasor Drive.

C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 368, at page 179, in which deed the grantors reserved the right to use said well.
