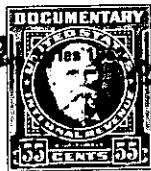

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. W. B. Stafford of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Love and affection valued at \$200.00 Two hundred Dollars to in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Burnett Stafford

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County, State of South Carolina

Being known and designated as lot # 24, having ~~14~~ ft cut off the north side of said lot running parallel 152 ft in depth leaving only 35 ft wide and a depth of 152 ft more or less, on the south side of lot # 24 also cutting of 8 ft wide 152 ft in depth off lot # 25 on the north side and adding it to lot # 24, making lot no 24, 44 ft wide running parallel 152 ft more or less
