CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, EDGAR M. NORRIS AND WESLEY M. WALKER

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 22nd day of October, 1952, file with the Secretary of State, written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREENVILLE TELEVISION COMPANY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To carry on, in all or any of the several branches thereof, the business of radio broadcasting (including frequency allocation and television broadcast time), in the manner and manner of doing business as may be appropriate to serve the public interest, convenience and welfare in connection therewith;

To apply for, receive, hold and enjoy and maintain, permits and grants necessary, appropriate or convenient for the erection, construction, maintenance and operation of radio stations (including frequency allocation) television studios, transmission, and receiving studios, equipment and facilities, and to maintain at Greenville, S. C., to erect, construct, purchase, acquire, lease, obtain, buy, let, sell, dispose of and otherwise deal in the same;

To contract with persons, corporations, firms, etc., injured or otherwise damaged with respect to radio and television (including frequency allocation and television broadcast time) stations, facilities, equipment and facilities, facilities, firms, persons, corporations, others having an interest therein, to repair, restore, or replace;

To transmit, disseminate, publish, exhibit, show, record, images, voice and motion pictures, and other forms of matter or matter or matter and to any other and or place known or hereafter to be discovered;

To manufacture, acquire, construct, install, maintain and to sell, lease, dispose of and maintain and operate, radio and television sets, apparatus, systems or equipment, electrical and other electrical appliances and devices, transmitter, receiver or combination, to maintain laboratories and conduct tests and experiments of inventing, developing and providing the same;

To create and produce radio and television (including frequency allocation and television broadcast time) programs, other forms of musical, dramatic and educational programs, contests, attractions and performances, and to present, sell, furnish or hire, and otherwise deal in and with respect to the same;

To hire, employ, contract with, furnish and otherwise transact business with relation to speakers, musicians, actors, singers, bands and all other types and kinds of artists, entertainers, performers and attractions, for any and all purposes; to give, and cause to be given, performances, exhibitions and retain the same;

To manage, direct, book, represent and, as agents or otherwise, to act for and on behalf of lecturers, speakers, vocal and instrumental musicians, conductors, actors, singers, writers, composers, and all other kinds and types of artists, performers and attractions;

To buy, lease and otherwise acquire, to own and operate, and to sell, let, and otherwise dispose of studios, theaters, restaurants, and other places of amusement, entertainment or recreation; and to give, and cause to be given, entertainments and performances of any and all kinds therein;

To purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, to maintain and operate, and to sell, let and otherwise dispose of radio broadcasting, television, sound recording, moving picture studios, machines, plants, and laboratories of all kinds and descriptions; to invent, manufacture, buy, lease and otherwise acquire, to maintain and operate, and to rent, sell, and otherwise dispose of any and all machinery, instruments, implements and devices of any and every kind and nature pertaining to the same; and to produce, reproduce, disseminate, and record aural and visual images, alone or in combination with each other, by means of films, records and other devices of whatsoever name or nature, whether now or hereafter known or discovered;
