in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The William Goldsmith Company, its successors and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and in the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest intersection of Springer Street and Judson Street, and running thence with Springer Street, N. 86 W. 399 feet, more or less, to a pin on Thruston property; thence with Lot No. 49, S. 51 E. to branch; thence with branch, which runs parallel with Springer Street, to a pin on Judson Street in line of Lot No. 39; thence with line of Lot No. 39 and Judson Street, in a northerly direction to beginning corner, being all of Lots 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39 that lies on the north side of the aforesaid branch, according to plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at Page 225. It being the intention of this deed to convey such part of said lots as lie between said Springer Street and the said branch as it not exists.
