H. Kenneth Dicely and Bonnie O. Dicely, their heirs and assigns, forever.

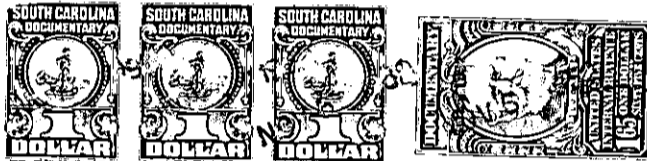
