All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southern side of McNeill Court, being known and designated as Lot No. 13 according to the plat of Wilton Oaks made by Dalton & Neves, dated June 1952, of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BE, at page 49, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of McNeill Court, joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 14, S. 1-03 E. 149.4 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence N. 79-15 W. 75.4 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence along the line of Lot No. 12, N. 8-46 E. 111.4 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of McNeill Court; thence following the curved line of the southern side of McNeill Court, the chord of which is N. 67-17 E. 65 feet to the point of beginning.

Office in Deed Book 462, at page 487, and subject to the right-of-ways, easements and restrictions contained therein.
