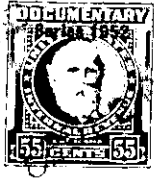

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Clyde Stokes, all that piece parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, on the head waters of North Saluda River and beginning on a rock and running approximately South east to a Poplar on the Emory Estate, thence Southeast to the Berry Field corner, thence Southeast to the Polar corner in Het Hollar, at the Plumley line and Emory line, thence along the Plumley line Southwest to the Rock line of Plumley line, thence North to the beginning corner, and containing Thirty acres, more or less. This is the same property conveyed to J.T. Lindsey in Deed Book 177 Page 85, and came to me as an heir of J.T. Lindsey and is recorded in Deed Book 365 Page 181, in R.M.C. Office Greenville County.
