Ashmore, Supervisor of Greenville County, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville County,

all that piece^s parcel^s or lot^s of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, a thirty (30) foot road known as Langston Drive, running from the Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road in Sans Souci Heights, a sub-Division situate on the New Buncombe Road about three miles north of the City of Greenville, and Earnshaw Avenue and Merriweather Street running from Lenore Avenue to the said Langston Drive as shown on Plat of said property recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book RR at pages 964, 91 which Plat is hereby referred to and made a part hereof.
