KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I- Ila Mae Stone-

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty & No/100 --( \$ 3,750.00 )-----Dollars  
to Me  
in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by C.N.Pittman and Velma M Pittman  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C.N.Pittman and Velma M Pittman

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, and known as lot # 6 and adjoining lot # 7, and  
having the following metes and bounds according to plat.

" Beginning at an iron pin on Highway No. 29 at corner of lot No.7  
and running thence along line of said lot # 7 approximately N-26-W  
218 feet more or less, to an iron pin on driveway ; thence along said  
driveway S-77-W- 171 feet to a post at corner of lot owned by Garrett  
formerly Grover ; thence along line of said Garrett S-19-E- 264 feet  
to a fence corner at edge of ten foot driveway ; thence N-76-E- 182  
feet to beginning corner. This is the first lot of land described in  
the deed by J.F.Murphee to Charles Archie Davis dated March 6th 1944,  
recorded in deed book 266 page 148, and in the correcting deed by J.F.  
Murphee to Charles Archie Davis 1944, recorded in deed book 267, page  
210.

ALSO.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land on Highway # 29, adjoining  
lot # 6 above described and having the following metes and bounds as  
shown on said plat.

Beginning at an iron pin on Highway No. 29 at corner of lot No. 6  
and running thence along line of said lot # 6, S-76-W - 182 feet to  
fence corner at of a ten foot driveway ; thence along said ten foot  
Along said ten foot driveway S-46-1/2- E - 116 feet to a point in center  
of Highway No. 29 in a northeasterly direction 126 feet to beginning  
corner. This is the same lot of land described second in the above mentioned  
deeds by J.F.Murphee to Charles Archie Davis and is referred to therein  
as containing 1/3 acre more or less. See above for recoding of said deed.
