In accepting this instrument, however, the grantee agrees that he will take such measures as shall be necessary to protect the drainage of the highway bed at this location, and that should any damage result from interference with the drainage of the highway bed, or adjacent properties, the grantee will save harmless and indemnify the South Carolina State Highway Department from any such loss or damage, or any liability resulting therefrom.
