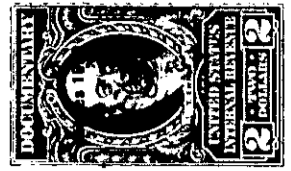
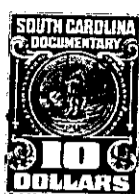

 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
 does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Basil L. Funk, his heirs and assigns, forever,

All that lot of land situate on the Southeast side of Mayo Drive, near the  
 City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown  
 as Lot 181 on plat of Paramount Park, made by Piedmont Engineering Service,  
 July 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.,  
 in Plat Book "W", at Page 57, and having, according to said plat, the  
 following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Mayo Drive at joint front  
 corner of Lots 180 & 181 and running thence with the line of Lot 180  
 S. 26-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-00 W. 70 feet to an iron  
 pin; thence with the line of Lot 182 N. 26-00 W. 150 feet to an iron  
 pin on the Southeast side of Mayo Drive; thence with the Southeast side  
 of Mayo Drive N. 64-00 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
