STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA AND 2 CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

This Contract and Agreement made and entered into this the 23rd. day of December, 1952, by and between Grady E. Lindsay, hereinafter referred to as Party of the First Part, and Ers. Annie Stewart Lindsay, hereinafter referred to as Party of the Second Part, both residents of the County and State aforesaid,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H:

That, whereas, the parties hereto are husband and wife, having entered into a marital relationship or ceremony on December 23, 1925, and lived together thereafter as husband and wife up and until about January 8, 1952, when certain domestic differences arose between them and they separated and are now living separate and apart; that, as a result of said relationship, two children were born to said union, one of whom is a minor 14 years of age and is now in the custody of the Party of the Second Part.

The parties hereto, realizing that it is not possible to have a reconciliation of their differences, and feeling that it is to their best interest, happiness and welfare, to enter into this Separation Agreement and bind themselves by the terms and conditions of same. And the parties hereto agree and bind themselves to live separate and apart hereafter as though no marital relationship was ever entered into between them and agree and bind themselves not to molest or interfere with the other in any way or manner whatsoever in his or her business, social, financial or domestic affairs.

It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that permanent custody of the minor child of the parties be, and the same is hereby, placed in and given to the Party of the Second Part, relieving the Party of the First Part from any
