KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, W. Shell Thackston and
Ada L. Thackston
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and love and affection
Dollars
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Edward Shell Thackston
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Edward Shell Thackston his Heirs and
Assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and in the town of Fountain Inn, being known and
designated as Lots. Nos. 5 and 6 on a plat of the property of W.
Shell Thackston made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, on March 29, 1946
and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.,
in Plat Book B, at page 131; said lots having a total frontage on
Thackston Street of 140 feet and running back, from the center of
said street, a depth of 220 feet and being 140 feet wide in the
rear, and bounded by Thackston Street, Lot No. 4 of said survey,
other lands of the Grantors and Lot No. 7 of said survey.
These lots being a small portion of the land conveyed to W. Shell
Thackston and W. T. Thackston by deed of Sallie Kate Woods on the
30th day of December 1919, said deed being of record in said R. M. C.
Office in Book 88, at page 594.
W. T. Thackston departed this life intestate on or about the 24th
day of March 1934 leaving as his only Heirs at law his wife, the
said Ada L. Thackston, and his son, the said W. Shell Thackston.
