All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina about three miles northeast of the City of Greenville on the south side of the National Highway and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 15 and 16 of Block "G" and having a frontage on Brookwood Drive of fifty (50) feet with a depth on the south side of One Hundred Forty Six and Six tenths (146.6) feet and on the north side of 145.8 feet and being a part of what was once known as the "Croft Farm".

The above lot is the same as conveyed to me by T. C. Stone, Trustee for Stella D. Stone, by deed dated January 2nd, 1934 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 198, at page 119.
