

to invest in my name in any stocks, shares, bonds, securities or other property, real or personal, as he may think proper, and to receive and give receipts for any income or dividend arising from such investments to vary or dispose of for my use and benefit as he may think fit.

8. To vote at the meetings of stockholders or other meetings of any corporation or company, or otherwise to act as my attorney or proxy in respect of any stocks, shares, or other instruments now or hereafter held by me therein, and for that purpose to execute any proxies or other instruments.

9. For all or any of the purposes of these presents to enter into and sign, seal, execute, acknowledge, and deliver any contracts and to draw, accept, make, endorse, discount, or otherwise deal with any bills of exchange, checks, promissory notes, or other commercial or mercantile instruments.

10. In general to do all other acts, deeds, matters, and things whatsoever in or about my estate, property, and affairs, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein doing all acts, deeds, matters, and things herein, either particularly or generally described, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.

11. And I, the said W. W. Carter, hereby ratify and confirm and promise at all times to ratify and confirm all and whatsoever my attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents, including anything which shall be done between the revocation of these presents by my death or in any other manner and notice of such revocation reaching my attorney; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me everything which my attorney shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof after such revocation as aforesaid shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who before the doing thereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.

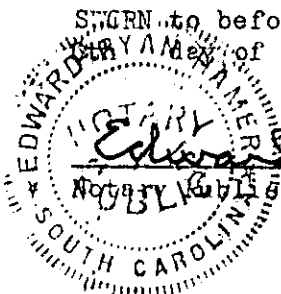
