KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Kilburn Mill,

a corporation,

in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 to it in hand paid by DUKE POWER COMPANY, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto said DUKE POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to go in and upon that certain tract or lot of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Lake Lanier on the South, East Shore Drive on the East, Kilburn Mill, Inc. on the North

and to construct, maintain and operate in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said line all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper maintenance and operation of the same. This line is to extend from the existing line now located approximately 300 feet east of Lake Lanier Dam, and is to run in a South-westerly direction, crossing Lake Lanier Dam, to the residence of R. B. Hall, which is located approximately 400 feet Southwest of West side of Lake Lanier Dam.
