Know All Men by These Presents:

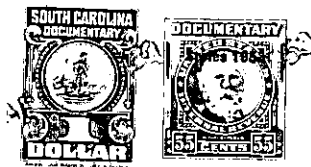
That We, Arbutus C. Garrison and Gladys Ethel Crowe Burroughs in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and No/100 (\$300.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Beatrice C. Jones, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being a portion of lot 30, Section B, as shown on plat of property of Alice M. and H. H. Willis, made by W.J. Riddle, November 193, and recorded in Plat Book K at Page 271, and according to a survey made by J.C. Hill on April 4th, 1953, is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, at corner of lot 31, and running thence with line of said lot, S. 80-30 E. 200 feet to a stake at corner of property of Beatrice C. Jones; thence with line of said property 75 feet to a stake; thence N. 80-15 W. 200 feet to a stake on Willis Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, N. 19-32 E. 25 feet to a stake; thence continuing with Willis Avenue N. 6-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

Grantee is to pay 1953 taxes.
