WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of March ,1953, the congregation of said Pentecostal Fire Baptised Holiness Church, an unincorporated association, at a meeting of its members voted to transfer the said property to Emanuel Holiness Church, an eleemosynary corporation under the laws of South Carolina, and instructed its present Deacons, namely, S. C. Richardson and S. C. Brissey, to execute a deed conveying title to said Emanuel Holiness Church, a corporation, a membership of said Pentecostal Fire Baptised Holiness Church having voted to sever relationship with said Pentecostal Fire Baptised Holiness Church and subscribe to the doctrine and discipline and become members of Emanuel Holiness Church, and,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emanuel Holiness Church, a corporation, its successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece or parcel and lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, shown on plat of Judson Mills Company Property known as Edgemont and designated on said plat as Lot No. 14 said lot has a frontage on Piedmont Avenue of Sixty feet and a depth of one hundred and fifty feet along Sixth Street; this being a corner lot for further description see plat of said Judson Mills Company Property Edgemont recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, at page 35, being the same lot conveyed to T. J. Bentley by Judson Mills by its deed dated 13th day of March, 1916, and recorded in R. M. C.
