That I, A.L. Cannon in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand One Hundred Thirty-eight (\$3,138.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said I.L.

Cannon and his heirs and assigns forever:

All of that parcel or lot of land in Highland Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the North side of the Few's Bridge Road, about three miles Northwest of Oneal, bounded on the North and East by other lands of A.L. Cannon, on the South by lands of B.M. Cannon and said road, and on the West by A.C. Rollins, being all of that lot of land conveyed to me by A.B. Cannon by deed dated April 11, 1942, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 244, at page 385, and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on an iron pin in the Few's Bridge Road, corner with lot formerly owned by Walter Rollins, now A.C. Rollins, and runs thence with the line of that lot N. 34.15 W. 224 feet to an iron pin on that line; thence N. 74.45 E. 208.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34.15 E. 224 feet to an iron pin in the Few's Bridge Road (iron pin back on line at 18.5 feet); thence along and with said road S. 77.45 W. 208.6 feet to the beginning corner, containing One(1) acre, more or less.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
