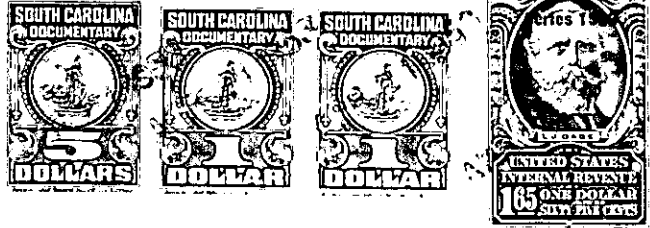

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said J. H. Allen,

Tract No. 1:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land containing twenty-seven
acres, more or less, situate in the County and State aforesaid, both
metes and bounds being fully set forth on plat of property of the
Estate of L. P. Jordan recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book H at Pages 272 and 273, said tract being shown on
the plat as Tract No. 2 and being the same tract of land conveyed to
Cary Sue Jordan by deed of Addie Jordan et al recorded in the aforesaid
R. M. C. Office in Volume 243 at Page 121.

The consideration for the above conveyance is the sum of
\$3,500.00, which amount was paid by the grantee direct to Rosa J. Owens
and Emma J. Nix as Administratrices of the Estate of Cary Sue Jordan
as provided for in the Decree of Court in the above entitled case.
