


BEGINNING at a White Oak tree on the Fork Shoals Road at the corner of Hendrix property and running thence N. 26-18 E. 993 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing N. 26-03 E. 350 feet more or less to a point at which a line drawn perpendicular would hit the southwestern corner of a cemetery, said line to the corner of the cemetery being approximately S. 63-57 E. 190 feet more or less; thence S. 30-44 E. 172 feet along the southwestern side of said cemetery to the center of a county road; thence continuing S. 30-44 E. 1220 feet to a point on the corner of Henry Willimon property and 46.50 acres since deeded to The Greenville Gun Club; thence N. 88-59 W. 931.6 feet more or less to a C. I. Monument; thence S. 76-42 W. 757.6 feet across Fork Shoals Road to a C. I. Monument; thence N.26-13 E. 225 feet across Fork Shoals Road to the point of beginning.
