to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. R. Williams, his Heirs and Assigns, a one-half, undivided interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles east of Travelers Rest between Travelers Rest and Paris Station in Little Texas section, containing two acres, more or less, and being shown on plat by W. A. Hester dated June 27, 1946, revised Dec. 17, 1946, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in private road of W. T. Henderson in line of Ferguson property, said pin being 1.18 chains from the northwest corner of the original 15 1/2 acre tract, and running thence along said private road - way S. 26 1/2 E., 6 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 74 E. 7.24 chains to an iron pin in line of Ferguson property; thence along line of said Ferguson property N. 70 W., 10.23 chains to the beginning corner.

Being identically the same property conveyed to Grantee by Grantor by deed dated February 28, 1953, recorded in the R.M.C. office in Deed Book 473, Page 375.
