All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in School District 7-IC, now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as 90 feet of Lot No. 16, of Block A, and 25 feet of Lot No. 15, of Block A, of a subdivision of the Buist property known as Oakland Heights, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.
