in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and No/100' (\$200.00) DOLLARS,

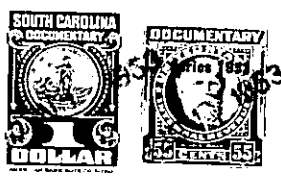

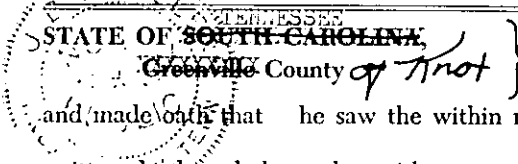
