to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said City of Greenville, South Carolina:

BEGINNING at a point of the west side of Summit Drive, joint corner of Caroline B. Heywood and William Goldsmith Duke, and running thence N 16 - 30 E 70.1 feet along Summit Drive to a point; thence still along Summit Drive N 11 - 30 E 70.0 feet to a point; thence S 88 - 30 E 7.7 feet to a point; thence S 12 - 0 W 70 feet along Summit Drive to a point; thence still along Summit Drive S 17 - 0 W 70 feet to a point; thence N 88 - 40 W 6.6 feet to the beginning corner

The strip of land above described is to be used for the purpose of widening Summit Drive.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and its successor and Assigns forever.
