QUITCLAIM DEED TO MINERALS

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the United States of America (hereinafter called the "Government") hereby remises, releases, quitclaims and conveys unto James T. Crumpton and Lidie Crumpton (hereinafter called the "Grantees", whether one or more), with the right of survivorship but not as tenants in common, all of the right, title and interest of the Government (except such interest as may have been reserved in patents or original grants issued by any sovereign authority, including but not limited to the King of England, the Lords Proprietors, the Province of Carolina, the State of South Carolina and the Government) in and to all of the oil, gas and other minerals in, on, under, or that may be produced from the lands conveyed by the Government to James T. Crumpton and Lidie Crumpton, his wife, by deed dated the 1st day of May, 1943, and recorded in Book 254, Page 40, in the land records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, together with all of the right, title and interest of the Government in, to, and under any leases, permits, contracts or other instruments to the extent that they cover said minerals and mineral interests hereby quitclaimed, including any rentals for any lease year or years beginning after the date hereof, any minimum royalties becoming due and payable after the date hereof, and any royalties or other income on production after date hereof, reserving, however, unto the Government any rentals for any lease year or years beginning prior to the date hereof, any minimum royalties due and payable on or before the date hereof, and any royalties or other income on production prior to the date hereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Grantees, with the right of survivorship, but not as tenants in common, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
