All of that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being located in Butler Township, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 6 and 7, as shown on plat of property of Baxter P. Freeman, made by H. S. Brockman, registered surveyor, April 30, 1952, said lots being more fully described as follows according to said plat:



Description of lot no. 6: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Fish Hatchery Road, joint front corner of Lots nos. 5 and 6, and running thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 N. 86-02 W. 215 feet to iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 6 N. 14-45 E. 102.5 feet to iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, S. 87-16 E. 171.6 feet to iron pin on Fish Hatchery Road; thence along said Fish Hatchery Road S. 10-05 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.



Description of lot no. 7: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Fish Hatchery Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 and running thence along said Fish Hatchery Road N. 7-17 W. 100 feet to an iron pin joint front corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 7 and 8 N. 88-02 W. 132.8 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 7 S. 14-45 W. 102.5 feet to iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 S. 87-16 E. 171.6 feet to the beginning corner.
