

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars,
to me paid by the said John S. Ashmore

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said John S. Ashmore

"All that certain parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Minus Street, and known and designated as Lot No. 6 on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "F", at Page 146, more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point at the intersection of an alley and Lot No. 6A and running thence with said alley in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 42.6 feet to a point; thence in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 88 feet; thence in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 41 feet; thence along the line of Lot No. 6A S. $77\frac{1}{2}$ E. for a distance of approximately 89 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot conveyed to John Minus by E. Inman, Master by deed dated September 11, 1933, and is shown as Lot No. 36, section 9, Page 113 on the County Block Book, and is in School District 8GB."
