which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 30th. day of

July, A. D. 1953 file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the **Greenville Piedmont**, a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is

PIEDMONT AREA EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION, INC.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is **GREENVILLE, S. C.**

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to furnish a non-profit and non-commercial educational television broadcast service to the Piedmont area of South Carolina, and to make available to the educational and cultural institutions and organizations willing to provide suitable television programs, the necessary physical facilities and operational staff; to obtain and to hold appropriate authorizations from the Federal Communications Commission; to construct, operate and maintain a non-commercial educational television station to be used primarily for transmitting educational and cultural programs and for serving the educational needs of the Piedmont area of South Carolina, pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission governing non-commercial educational television stations; to obtain or to hold by contribution, deed or lease, real or personal property and funds to be used in connection with the operation of a television station; and to solicit and accept, in trust or otherwise, money and property from any source whatsoever to be used for these purposes.
