Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 153, at page 176, and WHEREAS, it was the intention of the City Council to convey to Mrs Bessie Murphy the northern one-half of lot 47-S of Springwood Cemetery,

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to correct the previous deed, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The City of Greenville a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration Greenville of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars, and the correction of a previous deed to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mrs. Bessie Bishop (formerly Mrs. Bessie Murphy) her heirs and a ssigns forever, That certain parcel of land in Springwood Cemetery in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known as the northern one-half of lot 47-S, having the following courses and distances, to wit: North 8-1/4 feet; East 11 feet; South 8-1/4 feet; West 11 feet. For the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the rights and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of the said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the ordinances of said City, and the rules, regulation and by-laws of the City-Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the grantee_____ hereinabove named, and ______Heirs and Assigns forever
