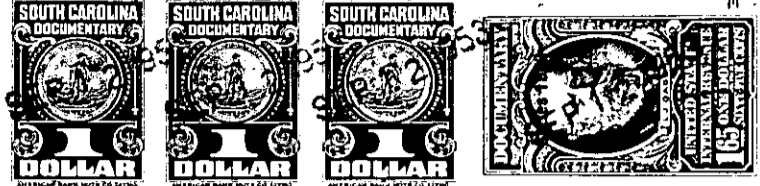

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 4th day of August 1953,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to C. Douglas Wilson & Co.
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree. and upon receipt of \$1446.40

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Bates Township,
Greenville County, South Carolina, on the eastern side of the Coleman
Road, containing 34.28 acres, more or less, according to survey made by
H. T. Corn, Surveyor. It begins at an iron pin 200 feet N. 33 E. from the
Coleman Road on the line of lands of Henry W. Coleman and runs thence
along the Coleman line N. 33 E. 1300 feet to corner in branch of C.
Douglas Wilson & Co.; thence along said branch which is also the line of
the Wilson Co. lands N. 63 W. 503 feet to bend; thence N. 62-30 W. 706
feet to poplar in branch; thence leaving the said branch and running S.
39-30 W. 388 feet to corner; thence N. 85-30 W. 250 feet to corner on
lands of Lillie Southerlin; thence along a new line through her lands S.
20 W. 280 feet to corner in the Coleman Road; thence along the Coleman
Road S. 22-30 E. 750 feet to bend; thence continuing along said road S.
41-45 E. 401 feet to iron pin in or on bank of said road; thence N. 33 E.
200 feet to iron pin; thence S. 41-45 E. 293 feet to the beginning corner.
