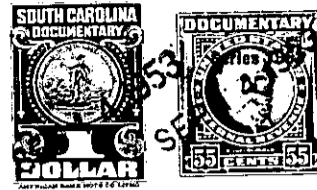

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina

On the branch waters of South Tyger River, and adjoining lands of
Dorthula Newman, Joe Pink Pittman and lands now an formerly owned
by J. D. Bridges and B. L. Still. This is the same tract of land
conveyed to John L. Pool by B. L. Still by deed dated August 12,
1909. Recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in
Vol. 4, page 602, and to B. L. Still by H. H. Turner by deed dated
December 30, 1905. Recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County in Book R.R.R., Page 553, containing fifty acres, more or

on the public road which leads from the Ridge Road above Cross
