

County. State of South Carolina, City of Greer, lying on the north side of Arlington Avenue and on the east side of Pine Street, in the northeast intersection of said two streets, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin in the intersection of said two streets, and runs thence with the northern side of Arlington Avenue S 72-00 E 75.6 feet to a stake, corner with W.
