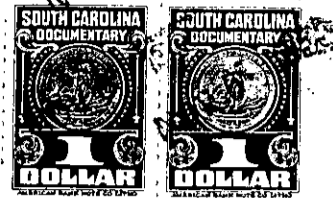

All my right, title and interest in and to  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying situate and being in Bates Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING on a pine X 3 on Tubbs Mountain Road and running thence N. 78 E. 4.67 chains to an iron pin; thence N.  $17\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2.70 chains to iron pin; thence N.  $68\frac{1}{2}$  W. 4.17 chains to a stake on said road; thence with said road S. 10 W. 1.70 chains to a bend in said road; thence S.  $11\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.45 chains to the beginning corner, said property containing  $2\frac{1}{4}$  acres, more or less.

The above-described property is the same conveyed to me by T. H. Peterson by deed dated July 21, 1937, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Vol. 199, Page 242.
