All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, Greenville Township, State of South Carolina, on the back waters of Saluda River, adjoining lands of Stanley Brown, et al, and containing three acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds according to a survey and plat made by J. Coke Smith and Son, Surveyors, July 3, 1950.
