Road in front of Grantce's property and Grantor places improvements upon the rear of his lot the Grantee will not have the right to go upon the premises of the Grantor to make repairs which would disturb the then use of the Grantor's primises without the written consent of the Grantor but said sewer like shall remain the property of the Grantee, its Successors and Assig s, and may be serviced thereafter provided the Grantor's use of his property be not disturbed or affected.

To have and to hold the aforementioned premises subject to the terms and conditions above outlined into Coble Dairy Products, Inc. of Lexington, North Carolina, its Successors and Assigns forever.
