in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Colie Fuller, his heirs and assigns forever: All my right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the Eastern side of Blythewood Drive and being known and designated as Lot No. 98 of Camilla Park, Map No. 2, shown on a plat thereof by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated December 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, page 85, and being more particularly described according to a plat by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated April 20, 1948 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Blythewood Drive, said iron pin being 345.3 feet from the intersection of Blythewood Drive and Frances Avenue, and running thence N. 89-22 E. 134 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 99; thence S. 9-28 E. 100 feet, more or less, to the rear corner of Lots 97 and 98; thence approximately S. 89-22 W. 169.3 feet to the front corner of Lots 97 and 98; thence N. 10-24 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to the grantor and the grantee by A. D. Grant by deed dated May 1, 1953 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 477, at page 389.
