described in the first two parcels of the referenced deed.

It is agreed that Smith or Smith and W. M. Phillips shall have the right to sell or mortgage any of the property described in the referenced deed for the support, health, comfort and well-being of W. M. Phillips without securing the consent of Phillips. In the event of such a sale or encumbrance, the applicable paragraph of this contract shall apply.

It is stipulated, however, that Smith may convey or mortgage any portion of said premises for her own use with the exception of the property described in paragraph one of this contract which may be conveyed or encumbered only for the health, support, comfort and well-being of W. M. Phillips. A sale or encumbrance by Smith for her own use shall not reduce the deed to be executed by Smith to Phillips upon the death of W. M. Phillips.

This contract shall be binding on the parties, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
